figured out how to conserve its resources and there is no threat of nuclear devastation. Would it be ideal? Almost. There are still some nefarious eco-terrorists who desire to control the world, even though most people have learned to get along with one another. In reviewing this book, one derives a palpable sense of relief because it gives the reader a sense of what it would be like to live in a benevolent future.

It is a progressive faith-based and open-hearted look at the conflicts and challenges that the 15-year-old protagonist, Raymond Sunstorm, and his astrophysicist father, Dr. Michael Sunstorm face after they are kidnapped by dark enemies and forced to assist in the covert takeover of the Solar government.

The world encounters its most serious threat ever, but positive mental attitude and technology save the day. This entertaining sci-fi tale is related like *Soylent Green meets Ben Hur*.

Robert A. Heinlein read it in 1978 and told my brother it was good, very original, and that he should get it published. Life just got in the way... until now.

The difference between *City Beneath the Earth* and alternate visions of dystopian futures, is the good guys... and Earth win. It provides a sense of Hope for mankind. When was the last time you got excited enough to feel like that?

The Global eBook Awards honor and bring attention to the future of book publishing: eBooks. Now in its second year, the Awards are in 72 specific categories. They are open to all publishers large and small so that a winner is the best in its category not just the best of small or regionally-published eBooks.
