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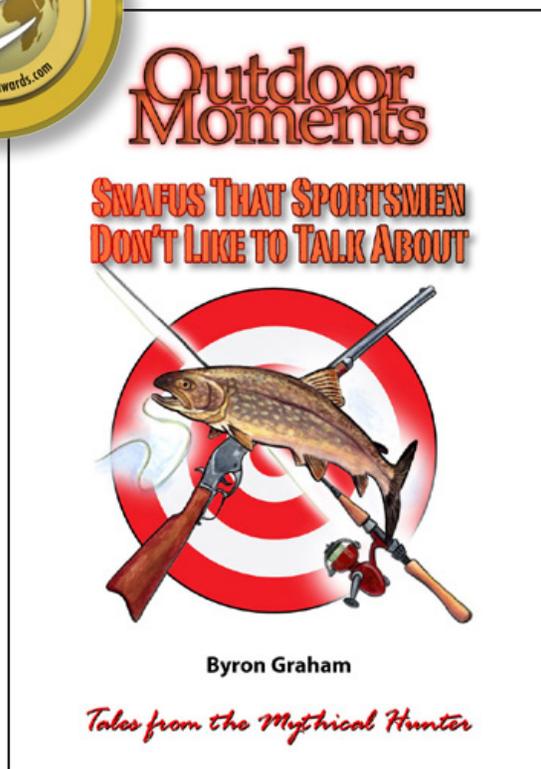

It turns out, that not EVERY hunting or fishing trip goes *exactly* as it has been planned out. That is, it rarely ever happens the way you expect. In fact, you can really get messed up sometimes. Sportsmen don’t always mention some of those episodes, because it might reduce your chances to go out again—That is... if your wife cares about you. (Most do.) Yep, the guy they call the mythical hunter, Byron Graham gets that a lot. He says... “It wasn’t MY fault the Grizzly wanted to get in the boat!”

This book reads like a real-life equivalent of Wile E. Coyote in his attempts to capture the quick-footed Road Runner in the great Warner Bros. cartoon series. Wrestling with a deer, hunting Buffalo with a bow and being chased by the herd, getting a “sinking” feeling as your boat springs a leak. While you are reading this, you will find yourself wondering... “How is this guy still alive?”

The “matter of fact” style that carries the story line also contains some good information about what it takes to be outdoors, away from civilization and the benefits that accrue from being out there. It takes understanding to successfully return from the wilderness—more or less intact.
